PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN PCVS ALUMNI ORGANIZATION AND TECH THEATRE

The Specialist High Skills Major Program has been in place at PCVS now for close to 3 years. This is a Ministry of Education initiative that affords schools the opportunity to have one or more specialty programs that will enable students who apply to acquire experience and certain certifications surrounding that specialty. The specialty at PCVS is Technical Theatre. PCVS while known for its academics and international work, has also been recognized and celebrated as the Integrated Arts School. The SHSM Program supports the schools artistic endeavours by building and designing sets in our construction technology classes and the various shows are costumed by our amazing

Fashions Arts program providing Specialist High Skills Major students 'real world' opportunities to gain experience and expertise. When this program was first implemented the PCVS Auditorium was revamped with improved lighting and sound facilities. Students in the program can acquire certification for "fall and arrest" training, "lift" training and numerous other certifications honing their experience and heightening their readiness for the world of work or of post secondary education.

Peterborough Collegiate teacher Dan Fewings is both a member of the SHSM Committee and a member of the Peterborough Collegiate Foundation. He had the idea of

partnering the Foundation and the SHSM program because he fundamentally believes that the SHSM program can and should be self-sustaining. Creating a concert series will provide SHSM students with real opportunities to practice the craft that they are specializing. The Peterborough Collegiate Foundation also looks for ways in which it can rally alumni to support scholarships for PCVS students as well as support other on going projects.
